recovered alongside the road several miles from the vehicle, where deputies believe Chavez-Diaz tossed it out during the pursuit.

Chavez-Diaz was the sole occupant of the vehicle. He is a resident of Veracruz, Mexico, and was booked into the Uvalde County Jail on charges of theft of a firearm, unauthorized use of a vehicle and evading arrest or detention with a vehicle.

The chase began at approximately 8:25 p.m., when Chavez-Diaz failed to stop at the U.S. Border Patrol checkpoint. Border agents began following the vehicle, while notifying the Uvalde Police Department dispatch center.

Texas Department of Public Safety, Uvalde County Sheriff's Office, Uvalde Police Department and Sabinal Police Department assisted. "Agents followed the

vehicle, which wasn't traveling at a high speed yet," said Dennis Smith with the U.S. Border Patrol's Del Rio sector public affairs office. According to the sheriff's office, Chavez-Diaz continued traveling east through Uvalde and Knippa before coming to a rest 5 miles west of Sabinal.

"Uvalde Police Department officers blocked all main intersections to assist and avoid any residents getting hurt by the

evading vehicle," said Uvalde County Sheriff's Office Deputy Emmanuel Zamora.

According to Zamora, the sheriff's office is working with the Kinney County Sheriff's Office to return the stolen truck and all recovered property to owners.

Chavez-Diaz remains at the Uvalde County Jail awaiting additional charges filed by the U.S. Border Patrol.
