For Class 2, Anna Vernor showed the second-place exhibit; Leila Mosqueda, third; and Colton Williams, fourth.

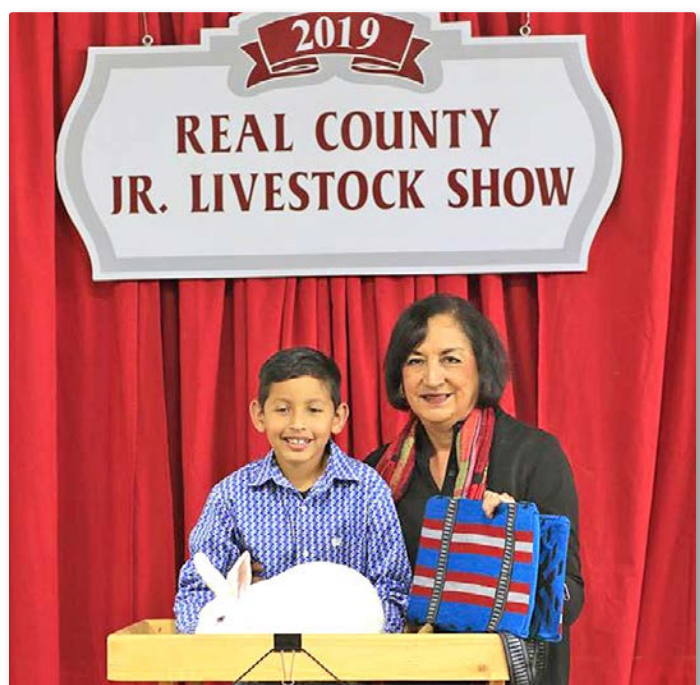
For Class 4, Averi Walker showed the second- and third-place exhibits.

In Class 3, Dodge Turner showed the third-place exhibit and Mathew Luce showed the fourth-place exhibit.

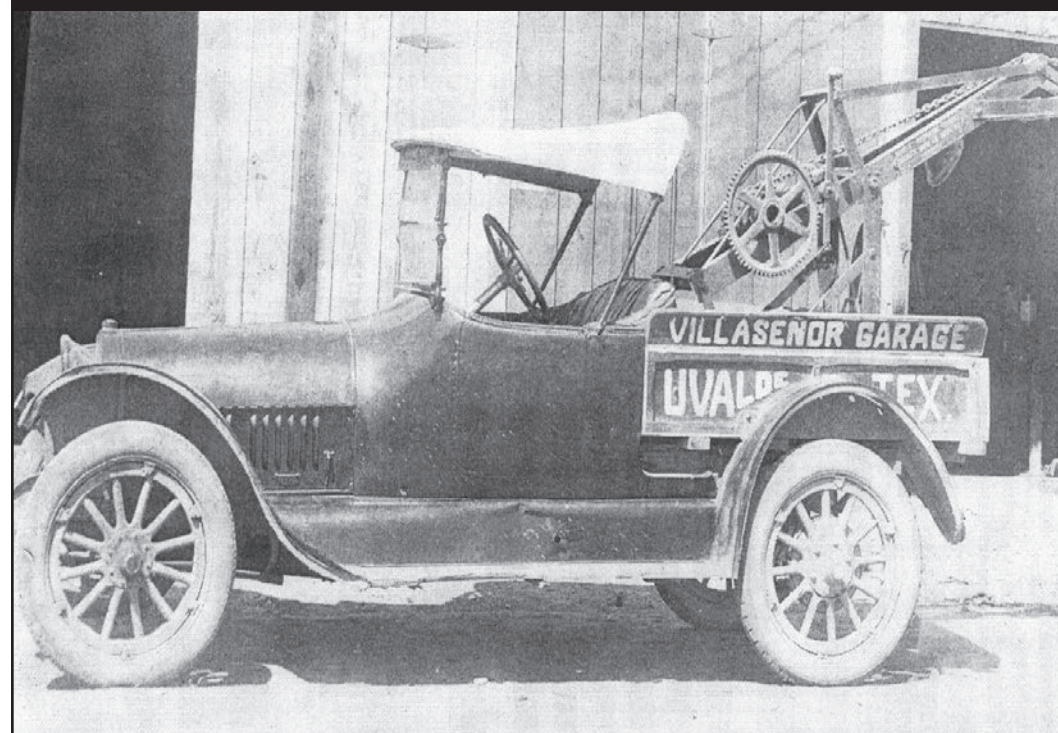
In Class 4, Kreed Light showed the third-place exhibit followed by Ian Garcia who showed the fourth-place exhibit.
