UTOPIA: Students inducted into honor society

AROUND TOWN

One hundred and three years ago, the commencement ceremony of Utopia High School was held in early May and 12 students received their diplomas.

The program consisted of the invocation by the Rev. A.J. Price, a piano solo by Lois Harper, Samuel Jones presented the class history, and Fred Smith performed a violin solo. Leobel Ware gave the prophecy, Lola Clayton, valedictory address, Superintendent J.E. Matthews presented the diplomas, and the Rev. O.G. Maltzberger dismissed the group with the benediction.

Class members included Edna Price, Mabel McReynolds, Lola Clayton, Leobel Ware, Lois Harper and Elma Hicks.

Leslie Bounds, Samuel Jones, Sidney Ray Harper, Fred Mansfield,

Sterling Fisher and Fred Smith finished out the roster. The high school had only 11 grades at that time, so most of these young people

were only 17 years old. Following graduation, Leslie Bounds asked his parents to sign for him to join the Army since he was not yet of age. World War I was raging on the European front and his parents must have wished that he had chosen another path, but they gave permission and he headed out to join the other Uvalde County soldiers.

After a few short months of training, the soldiers found themselves on the front fighting line in France. Bounds was

wounded on the first day and died a short time later in the base hospital a long way from his Utopia home and the parents who reluctantly signed for him to join.

Memorial Day is a day Americans honor those who lost their lives for our country. I've written this story of Bounds before, but it always tugs at my heart. If I remember correctly, my grandfather, a member of this class of 1916, remarked one day while visiting Jones Cemetery that Bounds was an only child.

I worry that our young people in today's world have lost the connection to these soldiers who fought so bravely and gave so much for our freedom on many fronts in many wars. We have to keep telling the stories and teaching patriotism. It just could be that the future of our country depends on it.
